Peppermint Sparkle Candy Cane Candle

What You Need

Tealight Cups with Soy Wicking
Feather Palm Wax
VCC Candle Dye Chips
Fragrance Oil
Heat Source and Thermometer
Pouring Pot
Skewers
Ribbon and Cello, Tealight Caution Label

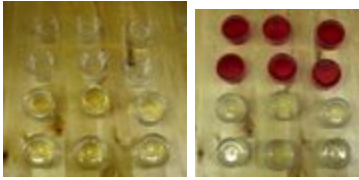


How To Make It

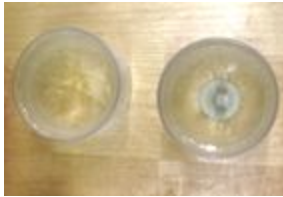
Prepare your wax. Melt wax in a double boiler or heat source. Heat wax up to 200F. One pound of wax will make approximately 30 tealights. Add 30 mls of peppermint fragrance oil or essential oil.



Pour half of your candles with just scent, no colour added, as full as you can get them, do not wick. Quickly add 1 red dye chip to the remaining wax. Pour remaining red tealights. If your wax starts to cool, your candles will not harden with a sparkly finish.



Once the wax starts to cloud on the bottom and sparkles start to form around the cup's edge (left), straighten the wick and lower into the centre of the cup (right). Your wick will slouch and down in the wax if put in too early.



Palm wax will harden with a fantastic sparkle finish. It will have a small hole in the top where the heat has escaped during the cooling stage. Do not attempt to refill. Trim wicks to $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch.



Cut cello into 6" x 14" pieces. Alternate white and red candles, seal seam with caution label and tie both ends with curling ribbon. Great hostess gift, teacher gift, secret friend gift.



Fits great in a stocking. Burns for 50 hours.
