Rolled Beeswax Tapers, Votives & Pillars

What You Need

Beeswax Sheets - Patterns for 8" x 16" Beeswax Sheets

#4/0 CottonWick

#1 Cotton Wick

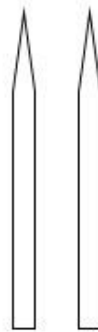
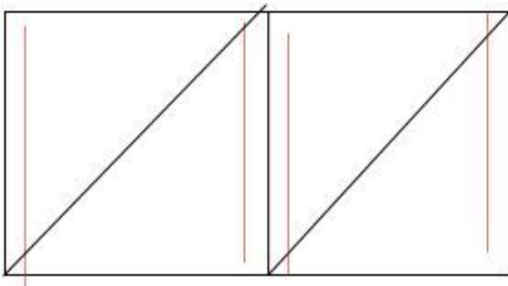
#3 Cotton Wick

How To Make It - Tapers – One Sheet

Cut on solid line

Wick on the dotted line using 4/0 wick

This pattern makes two sets of two



How To Make It - Basic Dinner Candle - One Sheet



Soften sheets with hairdryer to make them pliable. Do not overheat. Place #2/0 wick on sheet. Stop wick ½” from bottom of sheet so candle will self extinguish for safety reasons. Pinch wick into wax sheet and roll. At first your candle may not be very round, that is okay. It will correct itself.

Warm seam with the heat of your hand and seal seam, top and bottom with thumb. Trim wick. Bottom can be tapered to fit in various holders.

How To Make It - Votives - One Sheet

Cut on solid line

Wick on dotted line using #1 cotton wick

Pieces end to end make one votive, melt top and bottom to seal

Soften sheets with hairdryer to make them pliable. Do not overheat. Place #1 wick on sheet. Stop wick ½” from bottom of sheet so candle will self extinguish for safety reasons. Pinch wick into wax sheet and roll. At first your candle may not be very round, that is okay. It will correct itself.

Warm seam with the heat of your hand and seal seam, top and bottom with thumb. Trim wick. Bottom can be tapered to fit in various holders.



How To Make It - Pillar – Three Sheets

Requires three sheets end to end. Cut each sheet in half lengthwise.

Wick on dotted line using #3 cotton wick

Makes 1 3” x 4” pillar

Soften sheets with hairdryer to make them pliable. Do not overheat. Place #3 wick on sheet. Stop wick ½” from bottom of sheet so candle will self extinguish for safety reasons. Pinch wick into wax sheet and roll. At first your candle may not be very round, that is okay. It will correct itself.

Warm seam with the heat of your hand and seal seam, top and bottom with thumb. Trim wick. Bottom can be tapered to fit in various holders.
